

HIRTENKASE CHEESE



Hirtenkase or Herder cheese is a hard cow's milk cheese produced in the Allgau region of southern Germany and matured for at least 8 months.

In the region during the fall cattle are taken to graze on the slopes of the Alps and cheese is made from the milk of cows taken to graze.

The cheese has a yellowish color, rustic texture and aroma between parmigiano-reggiano and matured gouda.
