BETTINE GRAND CRU GOAT CHEESE



Bettine Grand Cru goat cheese is available as a familiar, soft, semi-hard gouda style fresh goat cheese. The advantage of goat cheese is that it needs a shorter ripening process compared to cheese made from cow's milk.

Semi-rigid goat cheese is white, with a slightly spicy taste, but with a texture of a paste that melts in the mouth.

Bettine's semi-hard goats are delicious to eat with bread, but they also combine perfectly with a good glass of wine. Due to a maturation of 8 to 10 weeks, they are full of flavor.
